An act to increase funding for non-athletic extracurricular programs.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: In order to ensure equal access and opportunities for non-athletic extracurriculars, Kentucky public schools will be required to appropriate a sum equal to or greater than 25% of the total athletics budget for non-athletic extracurricular programs.

Section 2: Extracurricular programs will be defined by all programs existing outside of the regularly scheduled academic day.

Section 3: Upon audit, if a school's budget does not meet the given requirements in regards to budgeting for non-athletic extracurricular programs, the following penalties will be in place:

1st time: the school will be fined 5% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic programs. 2nd time: the school will be fined 10% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic programs. 3 or more times:: the school will be fined 20% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic programs.

Penalties will be assessed by the state budget auditor.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect on the first day of the 2014–2015 fiscal year.
