1 An act to increase funding for non-athletic extracurricular programs.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: In order to ensure equal access and opportunities for non-athletic extracurriculars, Kentucky
6 public schools will be required to appropriate a sum equal to or greater than 25% of the total athletics
7 budget for non-athletic extracurricular programs.

8
9 Section 2: Extracurricular programs will be defined by all programs existing outside of the regularly
10 scheduled academic day.

11
12 Section 3: Upon audit, if a school's budget does not meet the given requirements in regards to budgeting for
13 non-athletic extracurricular programs, the following penalties will be in place:

15 1st time: the school will be fined 5% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic programs.
16 2nd time: the school will be fined 10% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic programs.
17 3 or more times:: the school will be fined 20% of total money being allocated by the school for athletic
18 programs.

19
20 Penalties will be assessed by the state budget auditor.

21
22 Section 4: This bill will go into effect on the first day of the 2014-2015 fiscal year.
