- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Each school is required to have a voting student representative on their SBDM council.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: The process for selecting the student will be decided through individual SBDM policy.
- 8
- 9 Section 3: Failure to comply will result in the reduction of funding for the district from the state.

- 11 Section 4: No additional funding is necessary for this bill.
