An act to require all Kentucky drivers aged 70 and older to take a driving skills test and a visual acuity screening in order to renew a driver's license

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Currently, a licensed driver in the state of Kentucky must renew their license every 4 years. However, there is no provision in our current law to ensure that the driver is still able to see and react well enough to drive an automobile. Drivers that lack that have lost the skills needed to operate a vehicle safely can be a danger to themselves and others. Our bill suggests that drivers over 70 years old in the state of Kentucky must take a driving skills test and visual acuity screening in order to renew their driver's license.

Section 2: This bill would add a requirement to the laws already in place regarding re-licensing drivers.

Section 3: The only cost associated with this bill would be the increased man hours required to provide additional testing.

Section 4: Failure to pass the driving skills test and/or the visual acuity screening would be immediate revocation of his/her driver's license.
