An act to provide safe houses for women suffering from abuse

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: In Chile hundreds of women are abused every year with no form of protection. When some women go to court, there is no protection given and the women are abused worse or killed before they get the chance for trial. We propose that we put safe houses spread throughout the country were women can go to have shelter when needed before, during and/or after a trial. We request the following:

Section 1: Each of these safe houses should include a medical clinic, a psychiatric clinic, and a kitchen to provide food and water, as well as rooms for those who need a longer stay. The doctors on staff (2–3 per house) should be certified in their field. Each of these safe houses should provide security for the women staying. The home is meant to be a temporary shelter for the abused women; not a permanent living space.

Section 2: After the women are deemed physically and mentally stable, or their trial has been complete, the women will be required to find a job and work a certain amount of hours each week. After one year of leave, they will be required to pay 10967.34 in pesos (\$20 US dollars.)

Section 3: We require the United Nations to fund this project in order to build and properly stock the safe houses. The houses in total will cost 3,500,000 in U.S dollars.

Section 4: This proposal will go into effect after a three year period to build and construct the houses.
