1 2	An act to clean Latin America's water
- 3 4	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
5 6 7	Justification Clause: Water is an essential part of everyone's lives. However, not everyone has access to clean, fresh water. Drinking dirty water can cause diseases and reduces quality of life. This proposal will help to fund the creation of water filtration and distribution systems throughout Latin American countries.
8 9 10 11	Section I: We are aiming to create a program that provides support through funding to help clean the contaminated water of Latin America.
12 13 14 15	Section II: The funding from this program will help to build water filtration centers throughout Latin America, as well as creating universal rules and regulations for companies who operate and have harmed or have the potential to harm the water sources of Latin America.
16 17 18 19	Section III: The U.N. will supply a set amount of money; this cash total will be decided by the U.N. after investigating the water conditions of Latin America. Furthermore, after they decide the set amount of money, they will then decide the distribution of money to each country based on their individual water needs.
20 21 22 23	Section IV: However, each country will be held responsible for it using the money given to them. For example, a country can choose to spend more on filtration or distribution of clean water, it is the countries' discretion on the movement of money.
24 25 26 27	Section V: The money supplied by the UN will not be wasted. It will be monitored by third party accountants. The third party accountants will make sure that the funds are being used to better the water supply however.
28 29 30	Section VI: We wish for this proposal to start making a difference in third world countries struggling with clean water.
31	Section VII: This proposal will be in effect start June 1, 2015.
