An act to establish an international council to control the rate and flow of immigration.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Due to the rise of aggressive military forces in the Middle East and central Africa, and the aggressive drug trafficking within the Southern Hemisphere, thousands of people are being displaced from their home countries and are left to immigrate to foreign nations. However, this mad crisis has caused chaos and has forced many people to become refugees. The enactment of this proposal will allow for a council to be established that deals solely with the protection, evacuation, and immigration of individuals into foreign countries.

Section I: This council shall be given the same rights and abilities as the Security Council. It shall have all the financial and governmental power, as well as the litigation needed to make it an equal power within the multiple independent organizations run by the United Nations (UN).

Section II: This council shall be made up of one representative from every member nation. This representative must have previously worked with their country's Department of Immigration, or have a high level of competency in the field of international relations.

Section III: The council shall have at its disposal legal, financial, economic, and health officials from within the United Nations. This is so that in the case of emergency or great need, the council may affirm individuals over certain areas that may need to be seen after on the international stage.

Section IV: This council shall work hand in hand with other UN appointed organizations, such as the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestinian Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFA), and the United Nations World Food Program (WFP).

Section V: After enactment by the General Assembly, the Council on the Affairs of Immigration shall be put into place and power January 1st of the coming year.
