3                                   **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

11   Section I: If enacted, all members of the United Nations must have a budget plan created by 2018.

13   Section II: All developed nations must have at least 2% of their energy usage come from renewable energy by  
14 2020.

16   Section III: All underdeveloped countries must reach the 2% goal by 2030.

18   Section IV: The percentage of the country's power coming from renewable energy must increase by 2% every  
19 five years.
