1                                   An act to create self-sustaining energy sources within Luxembourg.

3                                   **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5   Justification Clause: Luxembourg is a country known for its monetary assets and diverse culture.  
6   Luxembourg depends strongly on oil, in which they import from other countries. Luxembourg is one of the  
7   richest and smallest countries in the world, therefore it would be an ideal location to construct and render  
8   self-sustaining energy sources. These energy sources will be first used in Luxembourg and if successful, will  
9   be branched out to neighboring countries.

11   Section I: This proposal will be paid for by Luxembourg's taxpayers. The income from our energy exports  
12   will have great economic benefit to Luxembourg. The installation and operation cost will be €700,000  
13   (~\$950,000 USD) per year.

15   Section II: The power given to the nearby countries will reduce their electricity cost, and it will not generate  
16   greenhouse gasses that will help reduce the pollution.

18   Section III: These self-sustaining energy sources will help preserve Luxembourg's natural resources and save  
19   money over time.

21   Section IV: Construction of these properties will take place one year after ratification.
