An act to expand the number of permanent, veto-holding members on the UN Security Council

## Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: The current make up of the permanent, veto-holding members of the Security Council represents a very Euro-centric view of the world. All but one of the countries are European or of European origin. In order to alleviate conflict and provide a diverse perspective in world government, we must add more countries to the Council. This will allow formerly under-represented areas to settle problems through diplomacy rather than violence.

Section I: We will add five permanent, veto-holding countries to the Security Council in order to better represent the views of the entire world. These countries will be Brazil, Turkey, North Korea, South Africa, and India. All of these countries lie outside the range of currently represented countries, have large populations, and have a place in the international community.

Section II: In order to provide effective rulings, two countries must oppose a proposal in order to veto it. This will compensate for the increased number of veto-holding Security Council members.
