An act to request funds for the implementation of solar power energy stations throughout the country.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Due to the increase usage of non-renewable resources, Scotland seeks alternative methods of obtaining energy. Since the sun is a sustainable, renewable source of energy, Scotland desires to use its solar rays to create energy for its citizens.

Section I: A formal request of \$1 billion will be made by the people of Scotland. These funds will be used to construct, establish, and maintain solar power energy stations at key locations throughout the country.

Section II: A UN committee, comprised of representatives from countries with established solar power stations, would provide technological advice and assistance with the implementation of the solar stations.

Section III: After a 10 year period of production, Scotland would use profit margin money to re-pay the initial loan. An 1-2% interest will be added to keep up with inflation. This percent will be determined by the UN committee supervising the project.

Section III: Construction would begin as early as October 2014, in hopes of having a functioning station by summer of 2016.
