An act to decrease open deification rates in South-Eastern Asia.

## Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Sanitation facilities prevent human feces from contaminating sources of drinking water. Improved sanitation is as effective in preventing disease as improved water supply.

Section 1: The United Nations will compose a task force to visit countries in South-Eastern Asia and collect data on adequate sanitation facilities.

Section 2: The United Nations Social & Economic Department will collaborate with the World Health Organization (WHO) and United Nations Children Fund (UNICEF) to provide educational resources to school on the importance of hand washing and information on diarrheal disease.

Section 3: The task force will be comprised of delegates from the fourteen (14) countries that have made the most progress in reducing open deification rates. The task force will be supervised by the Social & Economic Department. The estimated time for the task force to be organized and sent to collect data in January 2015.
