An act to make it illegal for business or higher learning institutions to ask an applicant for their login information for their social media sites.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This act will make it illegal for Business or Colleges/Universites will to ask an applicant for their passwords to such social media accounts like: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Flikr, Tumbler

Section 2: Business or College/Universities will use the standard methods of background checks and not be allowed to use passwords they have obtained from applicants to such sites

Section 3: Business or College/Universities will not be allowed to have private investigators or members of their staff pose as friends or acquaintances of applicants on these sites to obtain information

Section 4: First time offenders will be have their organization fined \$500 dollars, second time offenders will be fined \$1000, third time offenders will be fined \$2000 and their hiring or application officer must attend a ethics in business hiring training for 3 hours and fourth time offenders will be fined \$5000 and their hiring or application officer must attend an ethics in business hiring training for 6 hours.
