An act to restore the horse industry of Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill is an act to restore the horse industry. We will do this by acquiring 2% of the profit from horse sales and race track meets in Kentucky. Companies meeting the following criteria are required to pay the tax.

- 1. They must sell Thoroughbred horses
- 2. They must be a public sales ground
- 3. Must make a profit

Section 2: This bill will acquire money to help struggling horse farms in KY that do not have enough money to restrict the sale of their horses to out-of-state buyers. This bill will be donating money to a fund that is known as the KBIF. This fund gives money to struggling horse farms in Kentucky, based on income.

Section 3: The first offense for failing to pay the tax is: the tax plus \$500 fine. The second offense for failing to pay the tax is: tax plus \$1000 fine. Every offense following will result in suspension of sale in upcoming meet.

Section 4: This bill would go into effect June 1, 2014
