1	An act requiring all schools to maintain a supply of epinephrine auto-injectors, also commonly referred to as
2	EpiPens, to treat severe allergic reactions that could be life-threatening.
3	
4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5	
6	Section 1: In addition to every school being required to maintain a supply of epinephrine auto-injectors, this
7	bill also allows for students over the age of 12 who have a prescription from a physician for epinephrine to
8	carry it with them during school and self-inject should they experience a severe allergic reaction.
9	
10	Section 2: As part of required professional development days, all teachers are required to be trained in
11	administering the injection.
12	
13	Section 3: The supply of epinephrine auto-injectors shall not get below one (1) dose per every 50 students.
14	
15	Section 4: If a public school is found not to be in compliance, it will face withholding of certain funding until
16	they are found to be in compliance. Private schools will face a fine of up to \$1,000.00 per violation.
17	
18	Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2014–2015 school year.
