An act to require individuals operating motor vehicles with a learners' permit to display a temporary vehicle marking.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: With no alert or indication when some motorists are learning to drive, there has been an increase in the number of accidents on Kentucky roadways involving minors possessing only a learners' permit. Motorists often exhibit impatience with drivers who they would otherwise expect to be more familiar with the rules of the road. This impatience can lead to defensive maneuvers resulting in accidents.

Section 2: This bill requires all drivers possessing a learning permit to display a temporary sticker with a universal logo indicating that they are a learning driver. The sticker shall be included in the price of the permit.

Section 3: When an individual acquires a permit, they shall receive one sticker and it shall be placed on the main car that they will be driving for the duration of their permit licensure period.

Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Transportation Division of Motor Vehicle Licensing shall carry out the regulations stipulated in this bill pursuant to their standard licensing responsibilities and procedures. State and local police agencies shall enforce this bill as part of their regular traffic enforcement routine.

Section 5: Failure to display a sticker when appropriate shall result in the following fines and punishments (plus appropriate court costs):

- First Offense: Warning
- Second Offense: \$25 fine
- Third & Subsequent Offenses: \$50 fine, 3 points against license

Section 6: This bill shall be effective July 1, 2014.
