An act to stop welfare abuse

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

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Section 1: When a citizen applies for welfare, the state will record the current amount of dependents that the welfare applicant currently has.

Section 2: A welfare recipient will only be allowed draw consecutively for two and a half years and any additional dependents, while on welfare, will not increase their benefits.

Section 3: A welfare recipient also may only draw benefits for 30 months out of a 60 month period.

Section 4: The Cabinet for Health and Family Services will be responsible for enforcing this law.

Section 5: The Cabinet for Health and Family Services will be responsible for funding this law.

Section 6: This law will be enacted on January 1, 2015.
