An act to create a database of the DNA of newborn babies.

**Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

Section 1: A database will be set up in order to store the DNA of all newborn babies in the state of Kentucky.

Section 2: The database will be used for future references by law enforcement as well as a crime deterrent.

Section 3: The Commonwealth of Kentucky will subsidize insurance companies who comply with the requirement of the bill. If they parents do not have insurance, they will be required to pay the fee unless they are eligible for welfare programs.

Section 4: This bill will be enforced by government inspections of hospitals every six months. If the inspectors find the hospital is not complying, charges will be in place as well as an increase to a monthly inspection to ensure the hospital is complying. The charges will go as follows, first offense: \$20,000 fine, second offense: \$50,000, third offense: \$100,000 fine.

Section 5: The cost of the procedure is approximately \$89 per baby.

Section 6: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2015.
