An act to require school trips have a certified staff member trained in CPR/first aid.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill will require that one certified staff member trained in CPR and basic first aid accompany school groups on all field trips.

Section 2: This will require at least one certified staff member to be trained in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and basic first aid. Training will consist of around 6 hours.

Section 3: This will provide a sense of safety among the participants by having someone able to respond to a cardiac emergency and/or other emergency situations.

Section 4: The schools will report the names and how many staff members are certified with CPR and basic first aid to the school board of education each school year. Schools must report which medically certified staff member will attend a school field trip in order to have the field trip approved. Schools will not be approved for a field trip if they do not have a certified staff member trained in CPR and basic first aid submitted to attend the field trip.

Section 5: The Kentucky Board of Education will monitor district school board's field trip approvals once a year.

Section 6: School districts found not complying with the law will be banned the following school year from all field trips for one school year.

Section 7: The cost of the CPR and basic first aid training will depend upon the instructors bill/cost. Each individual school will be responsible for the cost of having at least one certified staff member trained.

Section 8:This bill will go into effect 2014-2015 school year if passed.
