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5 6	Section 1: Kentucky has one of the largest populations of homeless people in the United States. We want all counties in Kentucky to be required to have a homeless shelter.
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8 9	Section 2: Having a homeless shelter in every county will reduce the homeless population in Kentucky. In the state of Kentucky there are nearly 7,500 homeless people and nearly 600 of them are military veterans.
