1 An act to set guidelines to decrease sport injuries in Kentucky.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4  
5 Section 1: In order to decrease the amount of injuries in contact sports, this bill will put the following  
6 guidelines in place:

- 7 A) Sports teams will have to have equipment up-to-date within 5 years.  
8 B) Sports teams will be required to have frequent water breaks and clean water.  
9 C) Players will be forced to sit out for the remainder of the season after 2 concussions.

10  
11 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) for all  
12 Kentucky school districts. School and county administrators will enforce the law at the Elementary and  
13 Middle School level.

14  
15 Section 3: Teams involved in contact sports who fail to follow the guidelines established in this statute will  
16 be subject to fines and/or probations as follows:

- 17 1st Offense: \$75  
18 2nd Offense: \$150  
19 3rd Offense: \$300 and head coach is forced to resign  
20 4th Offense: \$300 and program is put on probation.

21  
22 Section 4: No cost will be necessary except the replacing of the equipment which the coaches and sports  
23 program will pay for.

25 Section 5: This bill will go into effect July 1, 2014
