1 An act to prohibit people of all ages from riding in the back of trucks.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1- Presently, in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, it is legal for people over the age of 12 to ride in
6 the back of a truck. This bill would prohibit people of all ages from riding in the back of trucks.
7
8 Section 2- This bill will be enforced by the state law enforcement and will always be enforced on rural roads,
9 city roads, and highways.

11 Section 3- The exceptions for this bill would be if you were having a local parade or a hayride or for farmers
12 who are carrying farm employees from location to location for farm related work. Approval for all situations
13 has to be requested from your local law enforcement to be allowed to do so.

15 Section 4- There will be penalties for disobeying this law.
16 First offense- Warning and a \$100 fine
17 Second offense- \$500 fine
18 Third offense- \$1,000 fine
19 Fourth offense- Suspension of license from driver
20 Section 5- This bill will not require any funding.

22 Section 6- This bill will go into effect 90 days after passage.
