An act to require that all staff members in public schools in the commonwealth of Kentucky to be trained in first aid and emergency procedures.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: By having all staff members in public schools trained in first aid and emergency procedures, which would provide more immediate care in life or death situations, instead of risking a life when an ambulance isn't able to respond quickly enough.

Section 2: The cost to implement this bill would be a one time fee of \$200.00–300.00 for training of district nurses. Additional fees would be incurred for CPR training for district personnel. Funding would be through district resources and additional funding could be obtained from grants and/or partnerships with local hospitals.

Section 3: To implement all public school staff members to be trained in first aid and emergency procedures, the district nurse(s) would be responsible for training.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect for the 2014-2015 school year.
