

1 2	An act to require restaurant menus list the calories and carbohydrates next to each item.
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4 5	Section 1: This bill will require all restaurant menus in Kentucky to list the calories and carbohydrates.

	Section 2: People who may help the restaurants could be health inspectors and the Food and Drug
8 9	Administration (FDA). This bill will require all restaurants to list the carbohydrates beside the food and drink items. The bill will apply to all restaurants in Kentucky.

11	Section 3: This bill will be enforced by the Food and Drug Administration.
12 13	Section 4: The only cost of this bill will be the cost of a new menu.
14	Section 4: The only cost of this bill will be the cost of a new mend.
15	Section 5: The restaurant who is in non-compliance will:
16 17	1st offense: The FDA will warn the restaurant.
18	2nd offense: The restaurant will be fined \$500.
19	3rd offense: The restaurant will be fined \$1,000.
20	4th offense: The restaurant will be fined \$1,500 monthly until the restaurant puts the calories
21 22	and carbohydrates by each item on the menu. This money will go to help the government.

24 25	Section 6: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
25 26	Section 7: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2014, after passage and the signature of the Governor.
