1 An act to raise the funding for public schools in Egypt from 4% of the GDP to 6% of the GDP

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: The current funding for public schools is 74.85 billion EGP.

7 Section I: As of 2013, 83% of the educational fund in Egypt goes towards teachers and staff salary. 6.7 % is
8 allocated for educational requirements. 9.4% is allocated for educational investments.

10 Section II: The students and staff would be positively affected by the funding raise. The Egyptian gov't would
11 be in charge of funding schools. The Egyptian gov't would also be in charge of enforcement.

13 Section III: Funding shall begin in the school year of 2016-2017.
