1 An act to place drug peacekeeping officers along the South Eastern European Balkan Route.

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: Cocaine use and trafficking in Eastern and Southeastern Europe has increased
6 exponentially. Many countries in this region have registered recent increases or fluctuations in cocaine
7 seizures. Austria attributed the recent increases or fluctuations in cocaine seizures to its increased role as a
8 destination country and its more recent role as a transit country. Reports on the origin of cocaine in 2010
9 and 2011 from Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, and Ukraine point to
10 the possible emergence of cocaine trafficking routes overlapping to some extent with the established Balkan
11 Route.

13 Section I: In order to increase drug security around the entire Balkan Route, twenty-five thousand
14 peacekeeping officials will monitor all transit regions.

16 Section II: The United Nations Office of Drug and Crime will cover the expenses of paying for the
17 peacekeeping officers. Total expenses would average around 500 million euros (800 million US dollars). This
18 would pay for officer salaries, training, and all equipment necessary for effective route control.

20 Section III: This proposal will be enacted January 1, 2015.
