An act to place drug peacekeeping officers along the South Eastern European Balkan Route.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Cocaine use and trafficking in Eastern and Southeastern Europe has increased exponentially. Many countries in this region have registered recent increases or fluctuations in cocaine seizures. Austria attributed the recent increases or fluctuations in cocaine seizures to its increased role as a destination country and its more recent role as a transit country. Reports on the origin of cocaine in 2010 and 2011 from Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, and Ukraine point to the possible emergence of cocaine trafficking routes overlapping to some extent with the established Balkan Route.

Section I: In order to increase drug security around the entire Balkan Route, twenty-five thousand peacekeeping officials will monitor all transit regions.

Section II: The United Nations Office of Drug and Crime will cover the expenses of paying for the peacekeeping officers. Total expenses would average around 500 million euros (800 million US dollars). This would pay for officer salaries, training, and all equipment necessary for effective route control.

Section III: This proposal will be enacted January 1, 2015.
