An act to establish sugar cane as a primary alternative energy source in order to progress into a more environmentally conscious world.

## Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Pollution is one of the biggest global killers, affecting over 100 million people. That is comparable to global diseases such as malaria and HIV. People who live in places with high levels of air pollutants have a 20% higher risk of death from lung cancer than people who live in less polluted areas. By using sugar cane as an alternative energy source our inhabitants will benefit on a international level by decreasing the health risks prone to environmental factors.

Section I: Countries with proper climates and fertile land will be required to promote sugar cane farming and practice environmentally-friendly production of ethanol throughout the country.
