1 An act to establish sugar cane as a primary alternative energy source in order to progress into a more  
2 environmentally conscious world.

4 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

6 **Justification Clause:** Pollution is one of the biggest global killers, affecting over 100 million people. That is  
7 comparable to global diseases such as malaria and HIV. People who live in places with high levels of air  
8 pollutants have a 20% higher risk of death from lung cancer than people who live in less polluted areas. By  
9 using sugar cane as an alternative energy source our inhabitants will benefit on a international level by  
10 decreasing the health risks prone to environmental factors.

12 **Section I:** Countries with proper climates and fertile land will be required to promote sugar cane farming and  
13 practice environmentally-friendly production of ethanol throughout the country.

15 **Section II:** The UN will oversee that the countries carry out this act and are provided information and  
16 resources necessary to transform the sugar cane into an alternative energy source.

18 **Section III:** While ethanol production is costly, in comparison to other resources, it is less expensive. The  
19 production will also create numerous jobs and benefit the environment.

21 **Section IV:** This proposal will go into effect immediately after being passed. Steps will be taken by the  
22 countries to get this process started as quickly as possible.
