1 An act to expand the Security Council to represent more regions and world powers, and to introduce a veto-
2 override by a 2/3 majority vote.
3

4 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

6 Justification Clause: As world power shifts and spreads, the United Nations to stay relevant and respected in
7 all regions in the world. Instead of just representing a post World War II panel of winners, the United Nations
8 needs to recognize that it is no longer 1945 and world powers have shifted and grown. Also, the veto rule
9 decreases productivity of the assembly, and should be approached in a more democratic manner. A veto
10 from one member should not prevent the rest of the members from passing legislation. With a vote of two-
11 thirds majority, it should be possible to overturn a veto.

13 Section I: India, Japan, Brazil, and South Africa would be extended formal invitations to become permanent
14 seats in the Security Council. These countries should be chosen because of their population, locations in
15 underrepresented regions, and their Gross Domestic Product per capita in 2013

17 Section II: Legislation will be passed that will allow a two thirds majority vote on the security council to
18 override a veto.

20 Section III: These changes will take effect six months after passage.
