An proposal to to allow Developing Nations to take loans from the UN to pay off debts to Superpowers

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Currently, developing nations are unable to grow because of their reliance on superpowers. Loaning money to these countries would allow them to become independent nations and contributing members to the global world.

Section I: The United Nations will loan developing nations money in order for them to pay off their debts to megapowers.

Section II: A superpower is defined as a country with significant global influence through economic, military, and diplomatic persuasion.
