1 An proposal to to allow Developing Nations to take loans from the UN to pay off debts to Superpowers

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: Currently, developing nations are unable to grow because of their reliance on
6 superpowers. Loaning money to these countries would allow them to become independent nations and
7 contributing members to the global world.

9 Section I: The United Nations will loan developing nations money in order for them to pay off their debts to
10 megapowers.

12 Section II: A superpower is defined as a country with significant global influence through economic, military,
13 and diplomatic persuasion.

15 Section III: A developing country is defined as a nation with a GNI of less than \$11,905 US dollars.

17 Section IV: The World Bank will provide the money for loans.

19 Section V: Countries must be deemed not corrupt by Transparency International.

21 Section VI: The loans will be paid back through the revenue that the government will collect.

23 Section VII: This Proposal will go into effect June 1, 2014.
