- 3 4	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
5 6 7 8 9	Justification Clause: Most recent studies from the Federal Bureau of Statistics indicate that 12 million children ages 5–9 are child laborers. The international Labour Organization estimates that one quarter of the children are used for serious labor such as: slavery, commercial sexual exploitation of children, using children to commit crimes and doing dangerous jobs.
10 11 12	Section I: The Pakistan government will be required and assisted by the United Nations in implementing and enforcing new and more detailed child labor laws.
13 14 15	Section II: Parents and legal guardians who "sell" their children into labor trade will be held accountable by law.
16 17	Section III: Solicitors of child labor will be deliberately sought out and prosecuted.
18 19 20 21	Section IV: All Pakistan officers of law enforcement will be educated and trained regarding the harmful effects of child labor, the importance of stricter enforcement and the methods to use in the attempted eradication.
22 23	Section V: The funding will be provided by the United Nations Population Fund Association (UNPFA).

24 Section VI: All legislation, training, and implementation will be completed and in effect by July 1, 2015.
