An act to enforce the United Nations policy on sexual harassment on all public schools.

## Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Sexual harassment by teachers and students in public schools is a result of not enforcing an already insufficient policy. More than 30% of girls are raped in South African schools. Sexual harassment is a prevalent issue in American public schools, as well as public schools around the world. If there is no prohibition of sexual harassment, discrimination of females will only increase. The International Labor Organizations (ILO) has clearly defined sexual harassment and abuse in the United Nations system policies for workplaces. This act will extend the United Nations policy onto all public school systems.

Section 1: The policy will be enforced on the public school system as it is in the work place.

Section 2: Principals and department heads will be considered managers and bosses, and therefore be held responsible for the actions of the teachers, who will considered employees.

Section 3: This act shall be implemented at the beginning of the 2014–2015 school year.
