5 6 7	Justification Clause: In 1995, Sweden passed a law that would attempt to put a stop on prostitution. Through this law, it wasn't going to be the women who sold their bodies who got punished, but instead
8 9 10	those who choose to purchase and/or participate in the sex trafficking that is occurring in Sweden. Over the years, people have found loop holes in the system by bringing foreign girls to Sweden, promising them jobs, in return for selling their bodies.
11 12 13 14 15	Section I: The current punishments for purchasing sex in Sweden range from fines to prison time, however no one yet has been arrested. If people would begin getting punishments such as jail time, it will show people how serious Sweden officials are about this law.
16 17 18 19 20	Section II: To assist in stopping sex trafficking in Sweden, immigration laws will be made more specific pertaining to young women who are tricked into coming to Sweden, just to in turn be sold into sex slavery. The UN can assist in creating a policy that will allow victims of this to remain legally in the country, obtaining a work visa/ID to avoid deportation.
21 22 23	Section III: Countries included in the UN will be responsible for holding conferences and informing their citizens on the hardships that have been endured by victims of sex trafficking.
