An act to hold a UN conference for legislation of Anti- Terrorism ordinances.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Due to the increase in terroristic activities over the past two decades and the lack of a clear approach to combating it, ordinances and regulations on how to conduct military actions on terrorist organizations are needed on the world stage.
