1                                    An act to institute a new system of obtaining legal citizenship in Uruguay.

3                                    **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: We would like to institute a new system to better control the amount of immigrants  
6 that enter our country as to ensure we can keep our population under control. We currently are taking in an  
7 exponential amount of immigrants. We have a considerably low population density but our resources cannot  
8 keep up with the growth of our population. This issue also hurts other countries due to the fact that we  
9 export a good amount of beef. We export about 21% of beef. We are cutting back on exports in order to  
10 supply our country which is causing major disruption in international trade.

12 Section I: Currently in Uruguay we are quite open to accepting immigrants which is a strain on our resources  
13 and population. In order to become a citizen you must supply these documents.

- 14 a) Birth Certificate
- 15 b) Marriage certificate: This is optional. The advantage of filing a marriage certificate is that it enables  
16 only one of the spouses to have to prove an income source (see "d", below).
- 17 c) Police record
- 18 d) Proof of Income: The Proof of Income (PoI) requirement is fulfilled by proving that you have a steady  
19 stream of income to support yourself (and your family, if applicable). The amount of income you  
20 declare has to be consistent with your lifestyle. The PoI may be proven in a number of ways: a  
21 pension, dividends, rental income, or a work contract with a company in Uruguay, among others.
- 22 e) Tetanus vaccination
- 23 f) Medical check-up: A brief and simple medical checkup is required, from one of several authorized  
24 private clinics in Uruguay. This exam is fast, and it is not a screening test.
- 25 g) Proof of address: Uruguay requires that applicants have an actual address in Uruguay (a property,  
26 owned or rented). To meet the address requirement you have to provide a proof of residency issued  
27 by the police precinct nearest to your home. This takes only some minutes and you just need to show  
28 up at the police station in person with your passport and two witnesses who can simply verify that  
29 you live at the address you declare.

31 Section II: We would like to institute a new system to better control the amount of immigrants that enter  
32 our country as to ensure we can keep our population under control as to eliminate the strain that it is  
33 putting on our resources.

35 Section III: These requirements will be firmly set upon the passage of this proposal. It will go into effect a  
36 year after passage.
