An act to provide an option for diabetes education seminars in countries throughout the worldA

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: From just 1 percent of the adult Vietnamese population in 1991 the rate climbed to 6 percent last year. A survey in 2010 estimated that 1 in 10 adults had the disease. Vietnam is forecast to have between 7–8 million people suffering from diabetes by 2025. The International Diabetes Federation calculates that 371 million people were afflicted with diabetes worldwide last year. Four out of five people with the disease live in poor or middle-income countries. Vietnam will be used as a pilot country for this proposal.

Section 1: Ensure all nations within the United Nations provide seminars to teach children and adults of the causes and consequences of diabetes.

Section 2: Diabetes specialists from the UN will perform seminars in community buildings or tents based off the country's infrastructure.

Section 3: Countries will be encouraged by the United Nations to provide seminars in order to help the public good.

Section 4: This proposal will go into effect one year after passage.
