An act to create a solid and liquid waste disposal system in Belize to improve living conditions and decrease level of waste.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Nearly 90% of all Belizeans have no access to sewerage services. This creates serious sanitation issues for the people of Belize and the environment. Since this is such a serious problem, creating a disposal system would be the ultimate solution.

Section I: Belize will build new disposal centers to handle the large amounts of solid and liquid waste.

Section II: These centers will be funded by both Belize and the U.N. Belize will raise their departure fee and implement trade tariffs to help with the cost.

Section III: Establish a U.N. inspection team to monitor and enforce the building and maintenance of solid and liquid waste disposal system.

Section IV: Refusal to meet U.N. standards will result in a loss of U.N. funding for the disposal system.

Section V: This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage, with building expected to be completed by January 1, 2016.
