1 2 3	An act to diminish the amount of human trafficking, specifically in Asia, by creating a United Nations task force to do so.
4 5 6	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
6 7 8 9 10	Justification Clause: Human trafficking is a problem in almost all countries; however, is rarely prosecuted. It is estimated that there are currently 27 million modern day slaves as a result of human trafficking. This has created an unfair economic balance between those who take advantage of human trafficking victims, and those who pay their workers a fair wage.
11 12 13 14 15	Section I: The UN will assemble a task force of up to 300 specialists whose job will be to identify, locate and halt all human trafficking violators. The task force will be under the direct authority of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC). This task force will also have direct ties to the International Criminal Court (ICC).
16 17 18 19	Section II: This task force will have a trial run of five years, specializing in Asia. After the five year period, the issue will again go to the General Assembly on whether or not to continue the program, or to expand it to global proportions.
20 21 22 23	Section III: The task force will look for any human trafficking activity across any industry includingbut not limited to sex trades, manufacturing, and service industries. The task force will work with local authorities to capture and detain those who are responsible for human trafficking.
24 25 26 27	Section IV: Those who are accused of human trafficking will be tried in the country of which the crime was committed. If the Task Force deems the country unable to try the case then the case will be taken to ICC; furthermore, if the case is of global proportion then it will be taken to the ICC, as well.
28	Section V: The United Nations will provide the funding for this Task Force to be created and maintained. This

29 proposal will go into effect January 1st of 2015.
