1 An act to provide proper medical education by UN-certified doctors to current and future ones of Djibouti.

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: As of 2010, Djibouti has a life expectancy of 43.37 years, the seventh lowest in the  
6 world according to the American CIA (Central Intelligence Agency). This is largely accredited to the few  
7 doctors located throughout the country, with an estimated 1,220 people for every one certified medical  
8 personnel.

10 Section I: The United Nations will impose a law requiring surrounding countries to provide medical education  
11 assistance for the population of current and future doctors in Djibouti.

13 Section II: The United Nations will create a system of teams composed by certified medical doctors to send  
14 to Djibouti to create clinics and education centers. Which will give proper medical education to treat and  
15 prevent common diseases, as well as informatory classes instructing how to keep hospitals and medical  
16 centers safe.

18 Section III: The United Nations will develop a committee of trained officials to help overlook construction of  
19 new medical centers, the education of doctors and the funding of the Djibouti Health Project.

21 Section IV: The United Nations Development Program (UNDP) will fund the Djibouti Health Project.

23 Section V: This proposal will go into effect six months after passage by the General Assembly.
