1 An act to require all citizens 15 or older to complete training in order to be issued a bicycle license to ride on  
2 a major highway in Japan.  
3

4 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

6 Section 1: According to data obtained from the International Transportation Association, 118 Japanese  
7 citizens were killed while traveling via bicycle on a major highway, 13 of the 118 were children. In addition,  
8 18,973 were seriously injured while bicycling. Our proposal strives to provide bicyclists with training to  
9 assist riders in remaining safe while traveling via major highways.

10  
11 Section 2: This proposal will require all citizens to complete a training prior to being issued a license allowing  
12 them to travel via major highways. The training will cost \$15. Licenses must be renewed every 5 years for \$5.

13  
14 Section 3: The Japanese Department Of Transportation will fund this proposal . The department will use the  
15 fees obtained from individuals that pay for the bicycle training/licenses/license renewal, as well as the money  
16 from fines distributed.

17  
18 Section 4: Individuals who travel on major highway without being issued a license will be fined.

19  
20 Section 5: This proposal will go into effect 90 days after passage.
