1	An act to reduce suffering in Peru by establishing a public water system in each region of Peru.
2	
3	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
4	
5	Justification Clause: Peru's population is 29.99 million. Out of that, approximately 5.3 million people do not
6	have access to clean water. Roughly every ten minutes a child in Peru dies due to hazardous water. That
7	number can change with the help of Water Projects International (WPI) and the United Nations. Unsafe water
8	is the main cause of disease, poverty, and hunger throughout the world. If the water issues are not resolved,
9	then other issues such as health, governmental, and overall country advancement obstacles will not be
10	overcome.
11	
12	Section I: The United Nations will work with WPI to fund and dig wells to provide clean water for the people
13	of Peru. To dig the wells will cost around \$3,000 per well. For those who cooperate with the program, they
14	will receive free of charge, clean water from these wells. For those who do not cooperate, but use the water
15 16	will be fined. This fine will be \$50 for every infraction.
17	Section II: Funds provided by the United Nations and WPI will be used to dig wells, through the use of drilling
18	rigs, in the major regions of Peru such as Lima, Callao, Cuzco, and other largely populated regions. The
19	regions of Trujillo and Arequipa will also be affected. A pipeline, which will transport the water will be needed
20	as well.
