1 An act to provide college and career readiness classes in Scotland.

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: This is an act to provide college and career readiness classes for students enrolled in
6 grades 9-12 with an overall goal to lower the unemployment rate of Scotland and to better prepare its
7 young people for life, college, and/or the work force.

9 Section I: This will better the quality of workers and citizens in Scotland by teaching ethics and good life
10 skills. These skills would include how to handle income and expenses for that individual by hosting reality
11 stores. We will also address what steps to take to reach individual career goals. Our focus would be
12 teaching students all the essentials to be prepared for life after high school.

19 address ending in ".com." This will provide a substantial sum of money to pay for teachers and class
20 materials.

23 not only life after high school but life in general and how to be more of a contributing global citizen.
