An act to provide college and career readiness classes in Scotland.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: This is an act to provide college and career readiness classes for students enrolled in grades 9–12 with an overall goal to lower the unemployment rate of Scotland and to better prepare its young people for life, college, and/or the work force.

Section I: This will better the quality of workers and citizens in Scotland by teaching ethics and good life skills.
