An act to impose sustainable energy upon Switzerland in order to reduce the risk of future nuclear calamities and global warming

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Switzerland harbors one of the most competitive and successful economies on the planet. As global warming rises, its effects are beginning to interfere with their environmental status and one of their major industries: tourism, 40.85% of our country's energy is nuclear, which is a partial cause to the rapidly deteriorating conditions. Renewable energy sources are rarely apparent in our country, and if put into use often, can become an eminent and reliable source of energy, as well as save a copious amount of wildlife and stall global warming.

Section I: The UN would provide half the cost of the inspection of areas to decide where solar panels and wind turbines should be placed.

Section II: The UN would provide money to pay for solar panels and wind turbines to make renewable energy a more eminent source of energy for our country. Wind turbines are estimated at from a cost of \$3,000 to \$15,000 each, and solar panels are estimated at a cost of \$1.94 per square feet.

Section III: The UN would aid in the first 10 checkups on the state of the solar panels and wind mills to ensure their conditions.

Section IV: This proposal would go into effect on January 1st, 2015.
