1	An act to start an international disaster relief fund
2	
3	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
4	
5	Section I: The area our country Uruguay is all too prone to the threat of natural disasters, and the aid of the
6	countries has not been as accessible as possible. Thus having better relief fund to these countries is key to
7	keeping them stable after a natural disaster, or epidemic of some sort.
8	
9	Section II: The fund will be put together by countries willing to put money into it, including the country that
10	has the fund in place. The fund will only be activated for the country that has the fund. The money can be
11	used to help non-donating countries if the majority of the countries agree on giving them aid.
12	
13	Section III: The countries that have donated more will have more of a choice on what aid they get and how
14 15	much of it. They are allowed to get more than they donated as long as multiple countries agree on it.
16	Section IV: This proposal will take action 5 months after passage.
