An act to act to request a UN fund of \$150,000 to better train the elite Anti-Kidnap squad in Venezuela.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Venezuela has the highest kidnapping rate in the world. Every day, people are kidnapped and held at ransom. Due to this, the Venezuelan government created an elite squad to try and prevent and lower the kidnapping rate. So far, it has only made minor dents in the kidnapping. We would like to change that.

Section I: The money from the fund will go to the Anti-Kidnap squad. Using the funds, we will better train the squad at tracking and preventing kidnaps.

Section II: According to the government, an average of 46 people a day are kidnapped in Venezuela. There are also over 18,000 criminal bands that kidnap almost every day. Also, most kidnaps go completely unreported.

Section III: The Anti-Kidnap squad will be better trained in tracking and assisting those who have been kidnapped. This can help reduce the capture rate in Venezuela.

Section IV: As the Anti-Kidnap squad expands, it will help to put an end to the mass kidnappings that are occurring.
