4 5 6 7	Justification Clause: Many countries receive new water systems but are not trained on how to use them. Therefore they are unable to operate the systems.

20 21 22	Section IV: The U.N. will help by teaching people like Water Steps who are going down to the Dominican Republic to teach them how to operate the water purification systems.
23 24 25	Section V: Our proposal will be funded by the people who installed the water systems. For example, if you were the one who installed the filtration system then it is required for you to educate the citizens of the Dominican Republican how to operate the water system.
