## Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Many country's have economic and natural resources which they have developed a reputation for in order support their economy. These resources of vitally important to the country's economy. In France, we sell the famous Perigord Black Truffle, also known as the French Black Truffle.
